Admit: Admit your need for God and that you need God to forgive you for your sins. (Romans 3:23; 1 John 1:9)

Believe: Believe that Jesus is Lord; that He died for your sins, and rose from the dead. (Romans 10:9-10)

Confess: Ask Jesus to forgive you and take control of your life and then confess before others that you are a follower of Christ. (Romans 3:23; 1 John 1:9)

How do I unite with First Baptist Dandridge?

- By Baptism** after you have received Jesus Christ as Savior through faith. Baptism shall be by immersion in water and shall be administered as an act of worship during a future worship service. If you have any questions about becoming a member of FBC, please feel free to contact the pastor.
- By promise** of a letter of recommendation from another Baptist Church of like faith and practice.
- By statement** of prior conversion experience and baptism by immersion where no letter is obtainable.
- By watch care:** A college student of temporary residency wishing to maintain a permanent membership in a church of Baptist faith may join the church with all rights and privileges of church membership except voting.
