**Confess:** Ask Jesus to forgive you and take control of your life and then confess before others that you are a follower of Christ. (Romans 3:23; 1 John 1:9)

## How do I unite with First Baptist Dandridge?

- By Baptism** after you have received Jesus Christ as Savior through faith. Baptism shall be by immersion in water and shall be administered as an act of worship during a future worship service. If you have any questions about becoming a member of FBC, please feel free to contact the pastor.
- By promise** of a letter of recommendation from another Baptist Church of like faith and practice.
- By statement** of prior conversion experience and baptism by immersion where no letter is obtainable.
- By watch care:** A college student of temporary residency wishing to maintain a permanent membership in a church of Baptist faith may join the church with all rights and privileges of church membership except voting.

## Building Security Reminder

Effective January 7, 2018

We have begun to implement parts of our new security plan. The highest priority recommendation given by law enforcement and our consultants was to limit entry to the building to only the main doors and to have no exterior entry to the children's department. For this reason, only three exterior doors to the building will be unlocked for entry:

1. The main office entry near the Fellowship Hall
2. The Tower Entrance
3. The North Glass Entrance on the northern side of the building

If you require access to the elevator, we recommend parking near and entering in either the Tower Entrance or the North Glass Entrance.
