

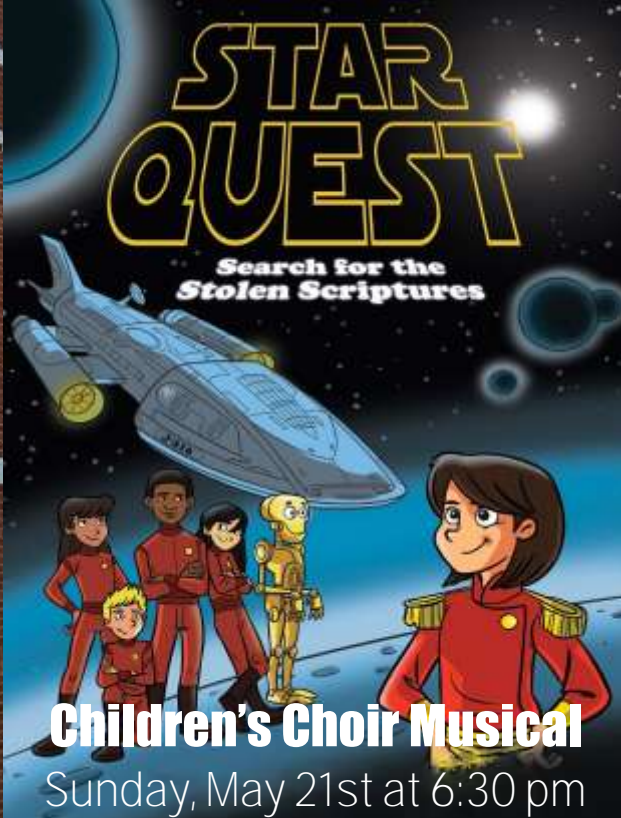

First Thoughts

Summer Study: "When Trouble Comes"

What do you do when trouble comes? One of the realities of living in a fallen world is that we experience a significant amount of trouble in our lives. Such trouble often comes in the forms of sickness, pain, anxiety, depression, broken relationships, poverty, grief, temptation, sin, and persecution. In many cases, these troublesome issues join forces with one another, multiplying the difficulty and suffering we face. In moments like these, life becomes painful and hope is hard to find, so what do you do when trouble comes?

Answering this question is key for those who want to live with the joy that Christ offers despite our circumstances. While life can oscillate up and down like a rollercoaster, how does Scripture teach us to respond when difficulty and trouble comes our way?



An answer to this question is given in a new book by Dr. Phil Ryken, "When Trouble Comes." Sharing honestly from his own life and looking at stories of men and women in the Bible who experienced many kinds of trouble, Ryken offers hope from Scripture aimed at reminding us that we're never alone in our pain. Though hardships and trials will come, God is our very present help in times of trouble. With story after story from Scripture, Ryken shows how the Bible accurately portrays our sufferings and how God meets us in the midst of them. Throughout this summer, we will be thinking through this book together during our adult Bible study on Wednesday evenings. As we consider the stories of Ruth, David, Elijah, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Mary, Jesus, and Paul, we will see how God's grace and love brought them through challenging moments in their lives. Even though the troubles they faced came in the context of ancient times, the solutions that God provided are still relevant today.

We hope that you will join us for teaching and discussion beginning on May 31, 6:00pm, in the fellowship hall. If you would like to purchase a book for this study (not required), they will be available for \$8.00. Feel free to invite neighbors and friends to join us. Children's activities and childcare will be available.
